MEMBERSHIP –

We have a total of 2769 paid bowlers in the VPUSBC for 2017-18 as of May 31, 2018. This does not include any additional bowlers we may have during the summer league season. However, this is a 2% decrease over the previous season. (WinLabs Report Attached)

FINANCIAL –

The account balances are included in the Financial Report in the handouts.

BVL –

Thank you to all that supported the BVL Mail-a-gram tournament this past season during the week of Veterans' Day. Through your donations this past season VPUSBC was able to send a check in the amount of \$4048 to help with the need of our veterans.

BFTC –

This season VPUSBC was able to send BFTC a check in the amount of \$7192.36 which was raised via the BFTC tournament, 50/50 raffles & league bowler donations.

AWARDS –

This season we have recognized the accomplishments of our 2769 league bowlers with 1443 local awards. 144 bowlers chose to donate their award money to either BVL, BFTC or the Youth Scholarship fund. At the League Officer Workshop to be held on Saturday, August 11, 2018 at the Tabb Library I will have the total monies donated by our league bowlers to each of the three charities. We are still working on improving our local awards program and are planning on a few changes for next season. These changes will also be presented at the workshop. In addition, there have been 124 honor scores (300 & 800's) reported to the association to be reported to USBC.
